Relay for Life commenced in Australia in 1999 with one event in Melbourne, at which 34 teams raised funds for cancer research and patient support programs. The following year there were nine venues for the overnight event and the funds generated grew tenfold.

With a unique structure and philosophy driving the national expansion of *Relay for Life* the ongoing success of the event contributed over \$7 million in 2004. In a surprisingly similar fashion, viticulture in South Australia's McLaren Vale spent many years building its bountiful reputation, for products of international distinction.

This 100% McLaren Vale Merlot was been barrel matured for one year prior to bottling in 2004. Rich and deep in colour, it has a lifted spicy fruit and oak nose. The palate is full and ripe with traditional regional characters.

Further cellaring is expected to see refined flavour development with chocolate and ripe berry fruit nuances interspersed.
