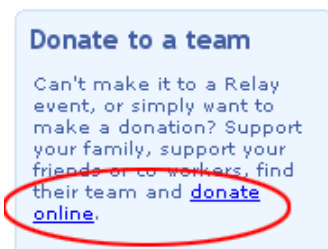
Donations online

Relay For Life teams that are registered with the Cancer Council of Victoria are now able to receive donations online for their specific team.

Steps to making a donation online:

Go to www.relayforlife.org.au web site, select Victoria

Bottom right hand corner is a "donate online" link within the "Donation to a team" box.

The registered team names for that event will then appear on the screen

Step One: Choose your team you wish to donate to and click "Donate to team" button. Fill in contact, personal and billing details, amount donating and (press confirm details button bottom right hand corner of screen)

Step Two: Confirm your details; you can amend your details before proceeding further. (Press Donate to team button bottom right corner)

Step Three: Fill in credit card information (press continue) and then Authorise Order Info (press Authorise this Transaction button or Reset). Confirmation details will then appear on the screen. Donations over \$2 are tax deductible and a receipt will be sent by email to you.
